- When training is completed, you will be routed to a consent form that you must submit in order to complete your background check for yourself through the NCS Risk website.
- You will receive an email from Sterling Volunteers telling you what to do next to FINISH.

Church Music Notes

Songs of Praise

One of our songs of praise today is Amazing Grace (My Chains Are Gone). John Newton wrote the words to this hymn as a personal testimony of God's goodness in transforming him from a slave captain, later captured and held as a slave himself, and finally becoming converted and a Christian minister. On his death bed John Newton said: "My memory is nearly gone, but I remember two things - that I am a great sinner, but that Jesus is a great Savior." The arrangement we sing today adds the refrain by Chris Tomlin, written for a recent feature movie, also named "Amazing Grace." The additional words go: "My chains are gone, I've been set free, my God, my Savior has ransomed me. And like a flood His mercy reigns, unending Love, amazing grace."

Ellen White once wrote about God's grace in Steps to Christ, p. 68: "In the matchless gift of His Son, God has encircled the whole world with an atmosphere of grace as real as the air which circulates around the globe. All who choose to



breathe this life-giving atmosphere will live and grow up to the stature of men and women in Christ Jesus."

Another of our songs today is *All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name,* No. 229. The words of this hymn came from England, and were written by Edward Perronet in 1779. Though

Perronet studied to be a clergyman, he was disturbed by corruption in the Church of England and joined with the Wesley brothers in preaching the gospel, undergoing persecution with them. For example, he is mentioned in Wesley's *Journal* as being rolled in the mud after preaching in Bolton, Lancashire!



The words of this hymn bring to mind the assembled saved of all the ages, as well as the angel choruses, singing praise to God the Father, Son, and Spirit at the time of the Second Coming

The music of this hymn by Oliver Holden originated in the newly-independent colonies in America in 1792. It is the oldest American tune in modern hymnody to be used continually. Holden was a carpenter and helped rebuild the town of Charlestown, Massachusetts, which had been destroyed in the War of Independence. He was a selftaught musician and conducted singing schools and edited several collections of sacred songs. A member of the Massachusetts State House of Representatives for 15 years, Holden died in Charlestown in 1844, a year which was also very important for Adventists. The introduction to this morning's hymn presents a fanfare by Frederick Swann, a second verse harmonized by Hal Hopson, and the rousing arrangement for the final verse today is composed by Margaret Mueller.
